
# David Clark's Eagle Project

# History of the Lucie Stern Fire Circle

- The Lucie stern fire circle has been a significant location ever since it was built
- It has been known and used by many as a place to gather and socialize
- Today, it is used by Troop 57 for meetings, skill practice, and gatherings.



# About Lucie Stern:

## Donor of the Fire Circle

- Lucie Stern, widowed wife of Louis Stern, was a significant donor to Palo Alto's community
- She was an important benefactor to the Boy Scouts Organization. One of her donations was the Fire Circle
- Built in 1937, this Fire Circle was an important part of Palo Alto's heritage



# Fire Damages Palo Alto Theater

Palo Alto (AP).—Fire caused extensive damage to the Palo Alto Children's theater today.

The blaze, which apparently started in the costume room in the basement, spread through a wing housing Boy Scout headquarters. Part of the theater lobby and a section of the auditorium also were damaged.

The center was a gift of the late Mrs. Lucie Stern, widow of Louis Stern, a nephew of Levi Strauss who founded the San Francisco clothing store.

The historic Palo Alto Fire Circle burnt down in a 1961 fire



**In 2002 the Lucie Stern Fire Circle was restored by the Boy Scouts.**

**The effort was the result of 800 hours of service from August to October, with many local Troops, with one of the major participants being Troop 57.**



# Moving Forward

Former Eagle Scout Larry Christenson was given \$10,000 by the Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company for his outstanding community work.

Mr. Christenson promptly donated the \$10,000 to the PacSky council to restore the Fire Circle

As well as funding the restoration of the Fire Circle, Mr. Christenson acted as the co-manager.
